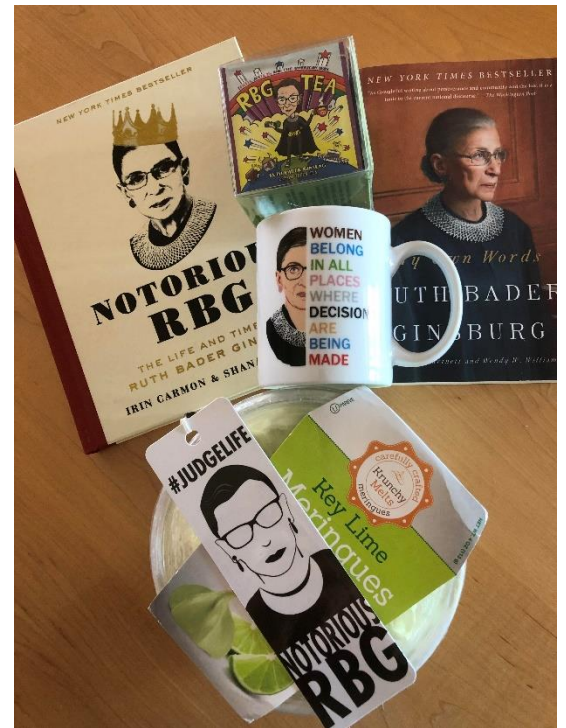

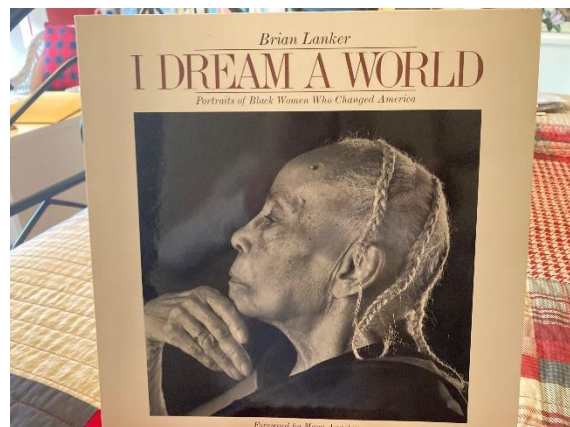

This tote can be carried over the shoulder or by hand. The lining and details are salmon and turquoise. There are two pockets inside and one on the front. It measures 15"x12"



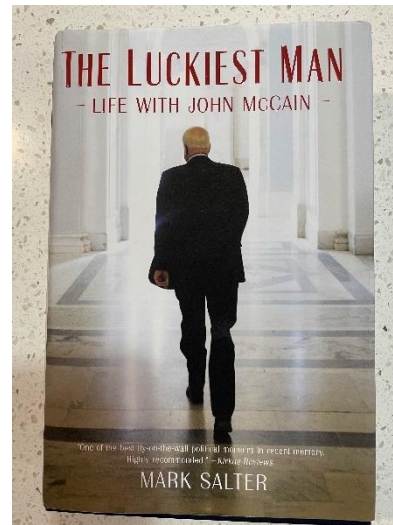

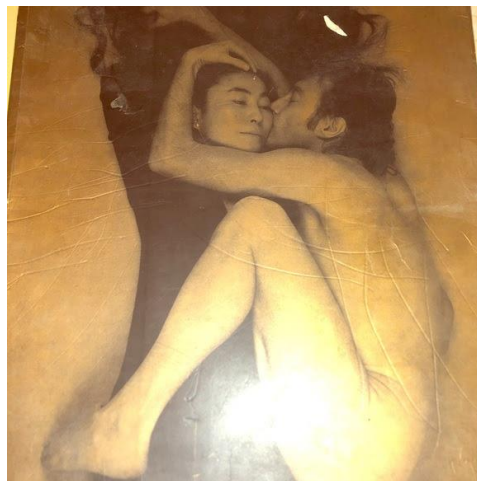
