Serving ADE

ADE leadership continues to prioritize supporting mental health + well-being of staff

- Created the first ever ADE "Wellness Toolkit" in response to COVID-19
- Routinely work with ComPsych and other partners serving state employees
- Provide space for leadership to share best practices with each other
- Hosted internal webinars to communicate and respond to concerns






Discovery Education

All Arizona educators and students will receive access to the award-winning Discovery Education Experience at no cost.

 Provides educators and students with virtual tools and resources, aligned to the Arizona K-12 standards.





ASU Digital Prep's Math Momentum

Designed to boost math and digital literacy skills in middle school-aged students

- Resources can be customized based on the participating schools' needs
- Now serving 5,000 students at over 40 schools severely impacted by the pandemic, with plans to expand further over the next three years
- Examples:
 - For schools struggling to find appropriately certified math teachers, the program provides a dedicated teaching partner to assist with instruction.
 - For schools with sufficient math teachers on staff, learning coaches from ASU work with and assist the on-site teacher in delivering engaging math lessons to support the individual learning needs of each student.

Arizona K12 Center's Teacher Mentoring

Keeping new teachers in the classroom beyond the first few years is critical to addressing the teacher shortage in our state

- Expanded mentoring program to 22 LEAs
- Builds a foundation of induction and mentoring by providing dedicated and trained instructional mentors for new teachers during their first three years in the classroom.
- Represent communities disproportionately impacted by the pandemic, as well as rural and remote districts with long-standing educator recruitment and retention issues.

- 140 new school counselor & social worker positions



Addressing the Digital Divide

- Technology Task Force
- Expanding rural broadband access through Final Mile Project
- Partnership with City of Phoenix to provide laptops/hotspots
- New ADE Office of Digital Teaching & Learning





Addressing Enrollment Declines

- Statewide enrollment decline of ~38,500 students in SY 20/21
- Launched Ready for School Task Force





AZ Ready for School

Launched statewide reengagement messaging campaign over summer '21

- ReadyForSchoolAZ.org & AZListoParaEscuela.org
- Enrollment Hotline
- Paid media ran for ~4 months
 - +65 million digital impressions
- English and Spanish TV and radio ads
 - Including paid spots during Diamondbacks and Suns playoffs
 - Billboards and grocery store/gas station ads







AZ Ready for School

- Student counts have begun to rebound
- Current ADM is up approx. 3.5% from September 2020 to September 2021
- Awaiting final enrollment numbers, to become available in the spring
- Trends are cause for optimism
